On Saturday 27th February, we had a serious incident in the club house when one of the burners on the gas cooker was left on, but the burner was not alight, allowing gas to escape uncontrolled into the building. We were extremely lucky that the club members who did enter the club house at about 4 pm on that day recognised the danger (i.e. potential major explosion) and did not switch on a light, but immediately switched off the gas and opened windows to vent the gas from the building. The committee has already arranged for an engineer to fix a lockable isolation valve to the main gas supply pipe to the cooker. In order that this event can never occur again, only members of the committee will be able to remove the locking mechanism to allow the cooker to be used. We do recognise that this may cause some inconvenience to members who wish to use the cooker in the club house when a committee members is not present, however in the short term it is guaranteed to prevent a similar occurrence which could possibly result in loss of life and the destruction of the club house.


